## NOTES FROM THE NURSE

- NO seasonal flu shots are available from Nurse Lisa this year. Check with your health care provider, Lubbock City Health Department, CVS, Walgreens or United for seasonal flu vaccine availability.
- We are tentatively scheduled for the City of Lubbock Health Department to do an H1N1 flu vaccine clinic at All Saints in mid-November. Children under 10 years of age will need 2 doses. The two doses will need to be received about 4 weeks apart, and we plan to have the Health Department do a second clinic in mid-December. Watch for updates on the web site, future editions of Patriot Passages. Paperwork from the Health Department will be sent home with students once the vaccine becomes available and the clinic date is confirmed.
- Vision, Hearing, Height and Weight Screening are scheduled for Friday October 23, 2009. This screening will be for students in PK, K, Pre-1st, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th and 9th grades. Parents will be notified ONLY if a student fails one of the screenings or if there is a concern identified during one of the screenings.

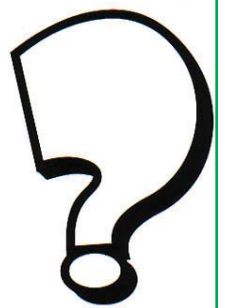
## **LOWER SCHOOL COMPUTER LAB**

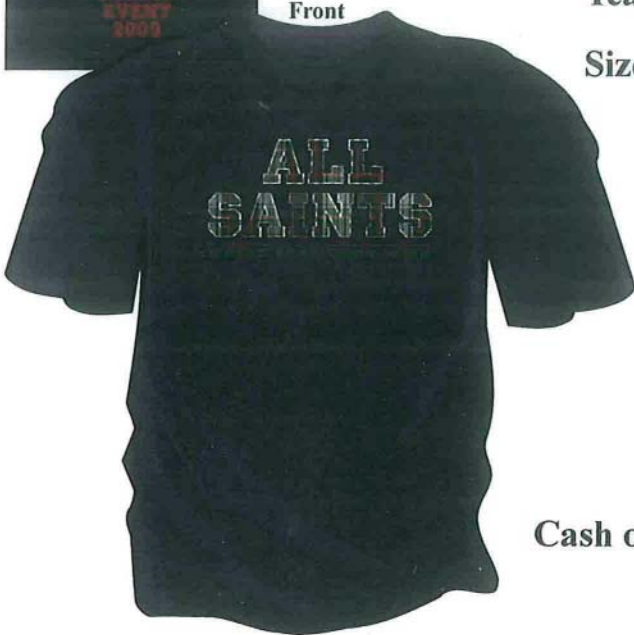
